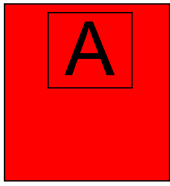
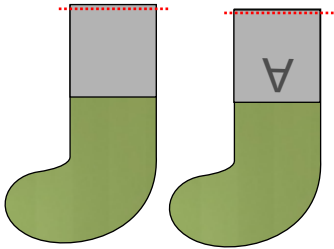


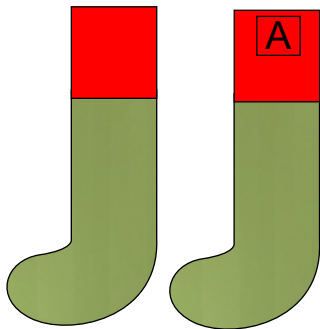
SEWING INSTRUCTIONS



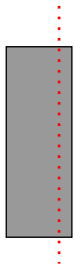
Embroidery your design at the top of your stocking flap.



Place the stocking flap over the Christmas stocking with the right sides facing. This will be the edge furthest away from your embroidered letter, as shown left. Now stitch 1/4" across the top.



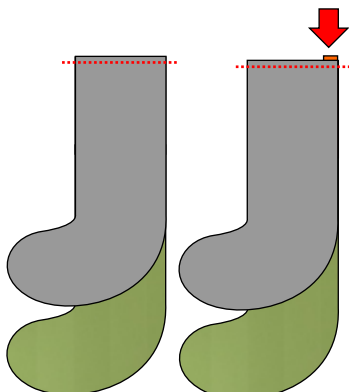
Unfold and iron down.



Fold the holder flap over with the right sides facing and stitch down.



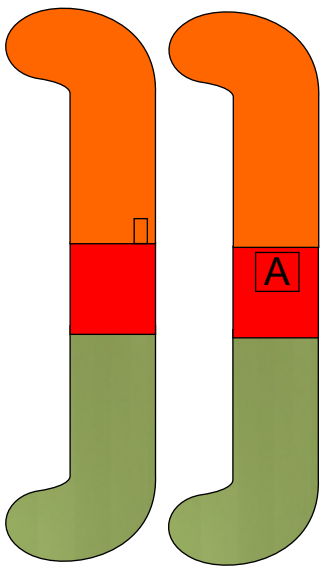
Turn inside out and iron flat.



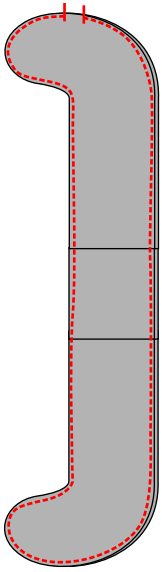
Place the Christmas stocking lining over the stocking flap with the right sides facing.

Fold the hanger over and this will be placed between the Christmas stocking lining and the stocking flap at the very edge, shown left by the arrow.

Now stitch 1/4" across the top.

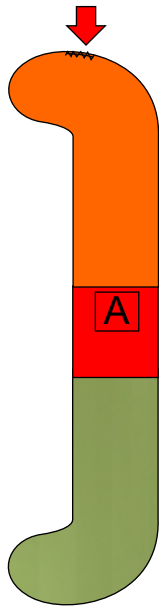


Fold out and iron down flat.



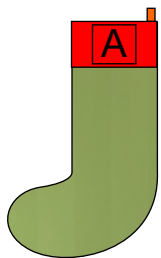
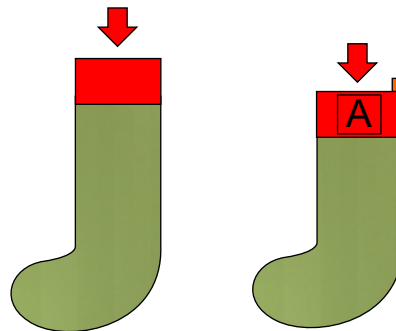
Now place together the Christmas stocking with the right side facing. Stitch 1/4" around the entire stocking leaving a 5cm gap in the stocking lining, shown left.

Once you have stitched around the stocking you can now trim into the corners of the stocking so that it will fold out nicely. Be cautious not to cut into the stitching.



Pull the stocking inside out through the gap in the lining. Hand stitch this gap closed.

Push the lining into the Christmas stocking. Line up the seams of the stocking to make it easier. Once you have done that you can then fold the stocking flaps down, as shown below.



Now that you have your stocking lining inside your stocking with the flaps sitting nicely over the top you can iron it all down flat.

This now completes your Christmas stocking.
