

KNIT MITTENS

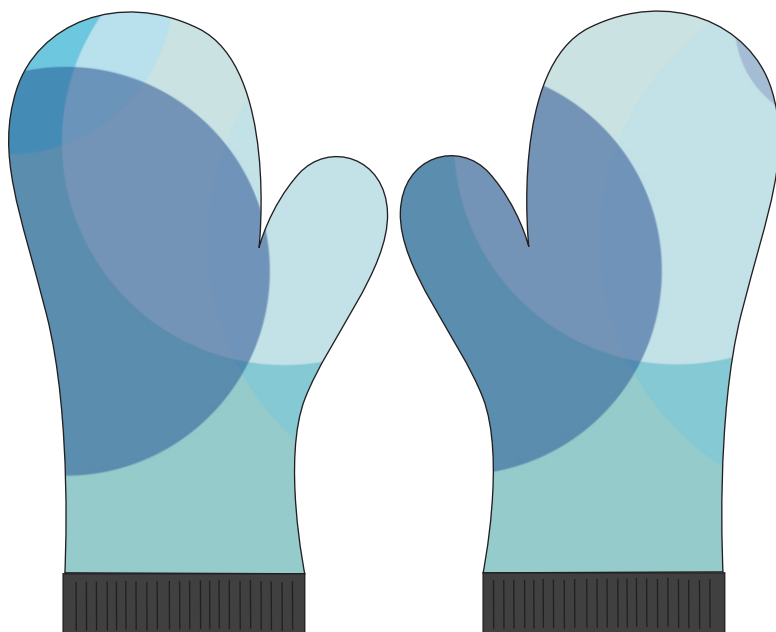
SEWING PATTERN

Material:

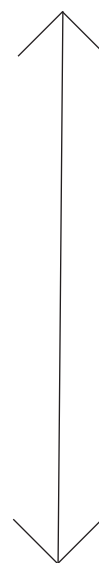
Mitten: Knit, sweatshirt or fleece

Band: Ribbed knit

TEST
SQUARE
5cm X 5cm



MITTEN BAND

SIZE SMALL AND LARGE



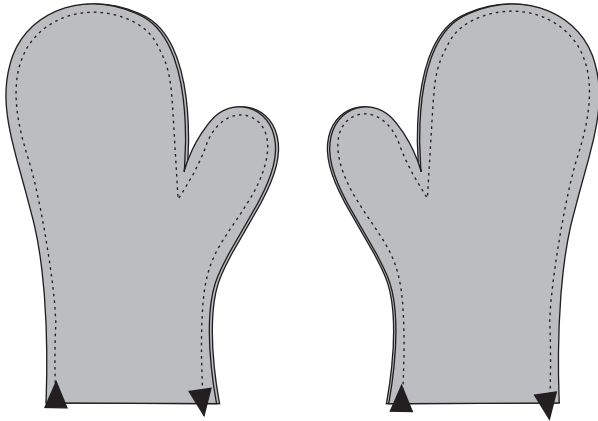
SIZE LARGE

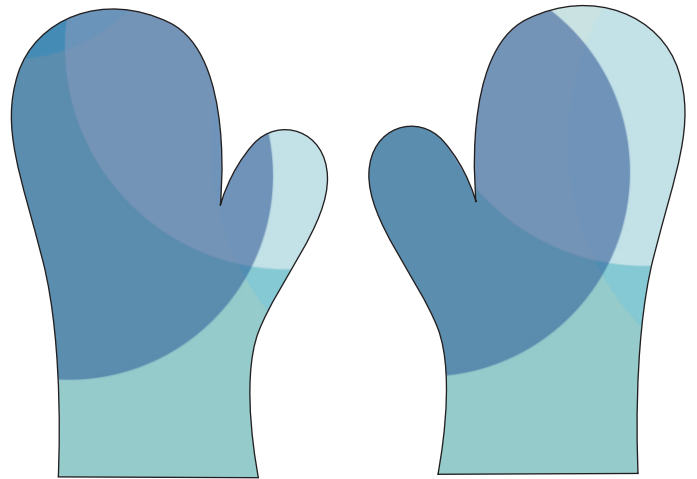
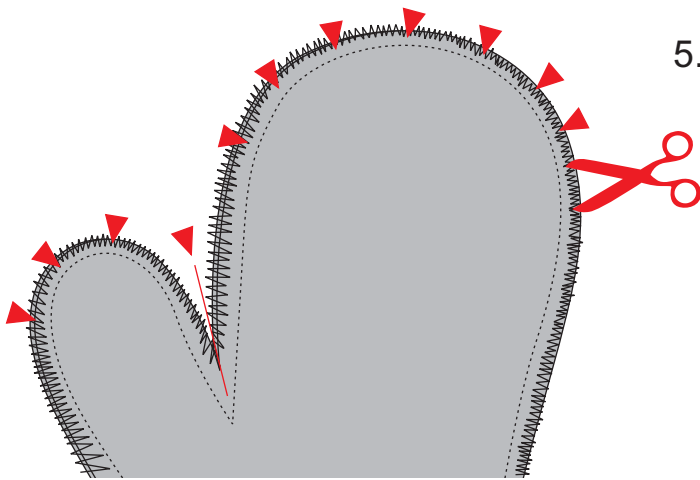
MITTEN

KNIT FABRIC



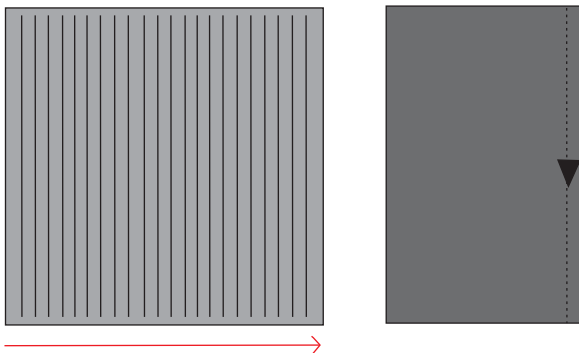
SEWING INSTRUCTIONS



1. Cut out your material, which includes 4 mitten pieces and 2 band pieces.
2. Starting with the mittens, place the right sides together and sew 1/4" around the outside of the mitten. Repeat for the second mitten.
3. You may want to overlock around the outside of this to ensure it has a nice finish.
4. Cut around the curved part of the mitten, without cutting through the stitch line. Shown in red, pictured right.
5. Turn your mittens inside out so the right side is facing.



6. Fold your ribbing fabric and stitch down the edge.



7. Now fold this down so that the right sides of the ribbing fabric is showing.

8. Place the raw edge of the ribbing with the bottom of the mitten and stitch along the bottom. You can overlock this to make the edges neater.

9. Fold the band back down, repeat for the second mitten and you are finished.
