## **ECHIDNA - BABY DRIBBLE BIB**



## **Materials**

- Thread to compliment Fabric
- 0.5 meter plain fabric (Tote Bag)
- 0.5 meter waffle weave fabric
- Snaps or Velcro

## **Tools required**

- Sewing & Embroidery machine
- Embroidery file
- Pattern Print-out
- Pattern Instructions
- Sticky tape (tape pattern together)
- Pins
- Scissors
- Iron
- Ruler or measuring tape



1. Cut off a peice of material large enough to use for this pattern. Embroider your material first before cutting out. If you cut the pattern first you may have problems hooping it up.



2. Cut the pattern out and place it over the fabric so that the design is in the center.



3. Cut out the Waffle Weave fabric from the pattern.



4. Place fabric so that the right sides are facing together and then pin in place.



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6. Sew 1/4 inch around the edge of the fabric making sure to leave a small gap as outlined by your pins.



7. Cut around the sharp edge and around the corners making sure not to cut your stitch line.



8. Turn it inside out through the small gap and iron flat.



9. Hand sew the small opening closed.



10. It is probably best to wrap the dribble bib around your child and mark with an erasable pen where you need to place the velcro or snaps.

We have used a machine snap in the picture above but you can also use sewn on snaps or velcro. Do not use buttons or anything that can be eaten or accidentally swallowed by your child.
