

## 000309. Initialed Cork Pouch

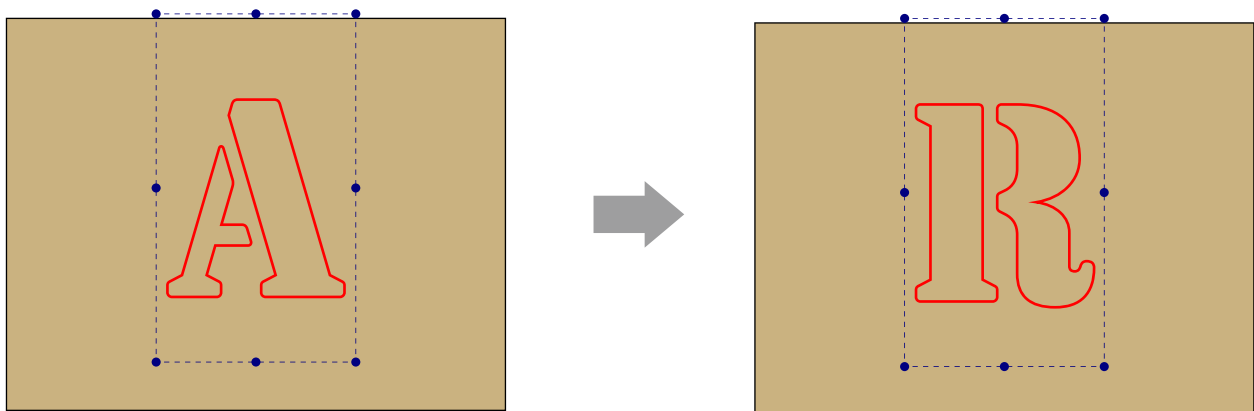


### Material (per item)

High tack adhesive fabric support sheet (CASTBL2)  
 Cork sheets (0.4 mm (0.02") thick) – 1 kind  
 Colored denim (lightweight) – 1 kind  
 Patterned fabric – 1 kind  
 Zipper with bead pull (20 cm (7.87")) – 1  
 Craft adhesive  
 Sewing machine thread  
 Sewing machine  
 Zipper foot (for zipper insertion)  
 Iron  
 Ruler  
 Erasable pen  
 Pins

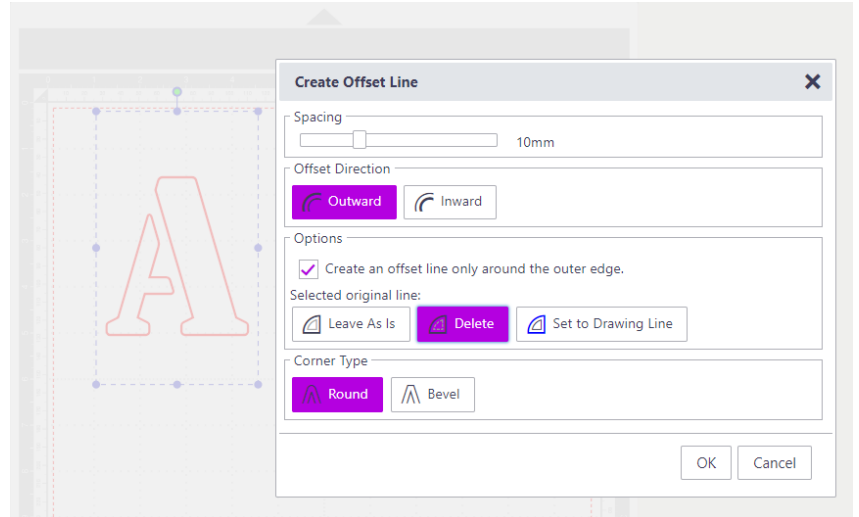
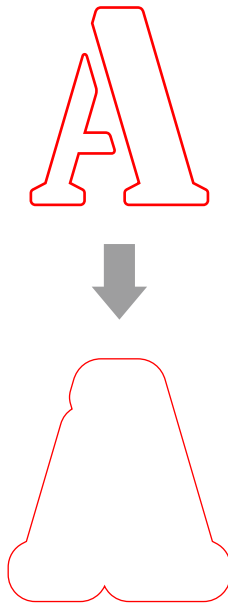
(1) Use CanvasWorkspace to change the letter (A).

[Example]



(2) If the letter was changed in step (1), also change the letter for part C.

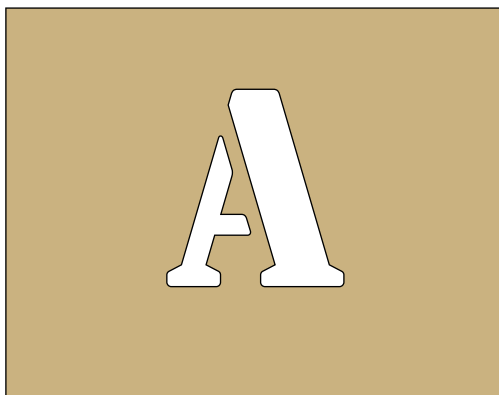
(3) Select the letter in the data for part C, and then specify an offset of 10 mm (0.39") to the outside in the [Create Offset Line] dialog box.



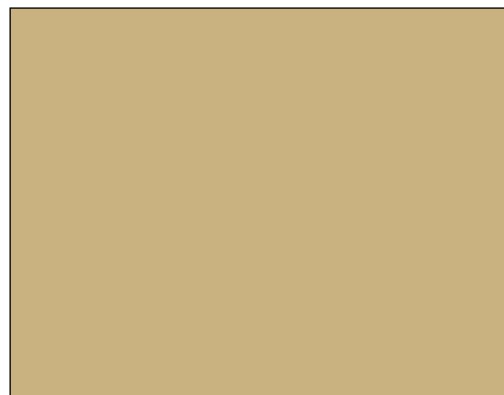
Options: Create an offset line only around the outer edge.  
 Selected original line: Delete  
 Corner Type: Round

(4) Attach the high tack adhesive fabric support sheet to the standard mat. (For details on attaching the sheet, refer to the instructions included with it.) Cut out A through C. Cut A from the cork sheet, cut B once from the cork sheet and twice from the patterned fabric, and then cut C from the colored denim.

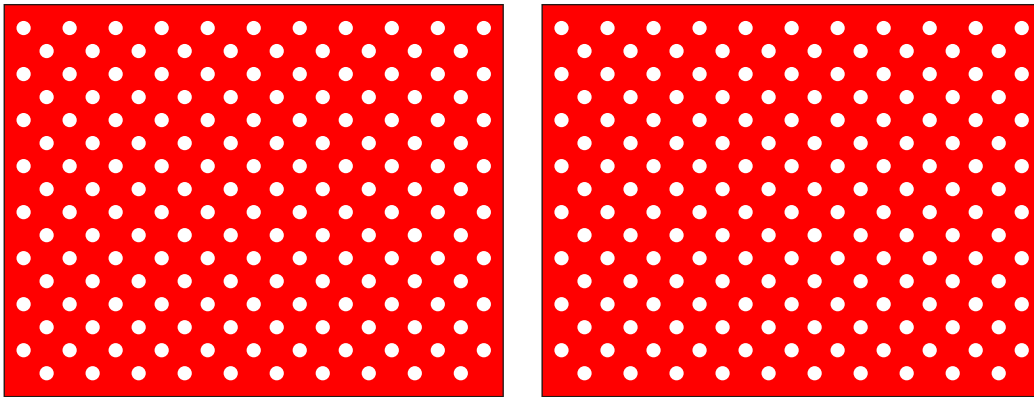
A (cork sheet)



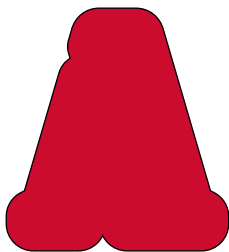
B-1 (cork sheet)



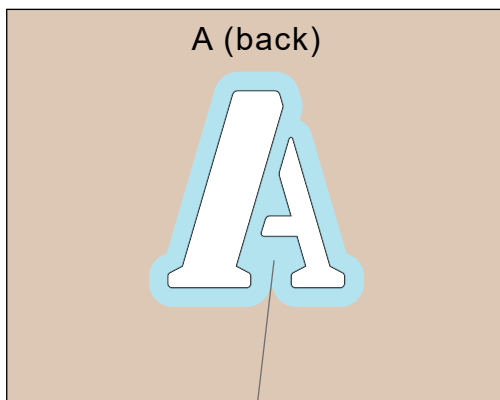
B-2 (patterned fabric)



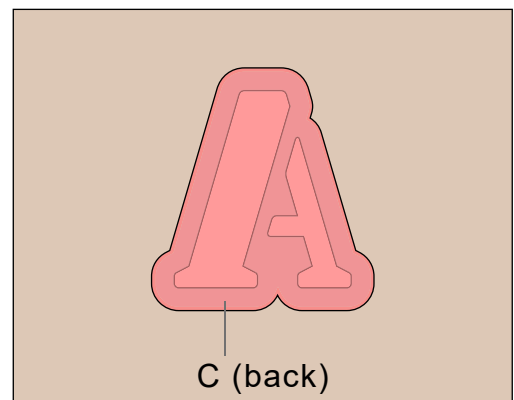
C (colored denim)



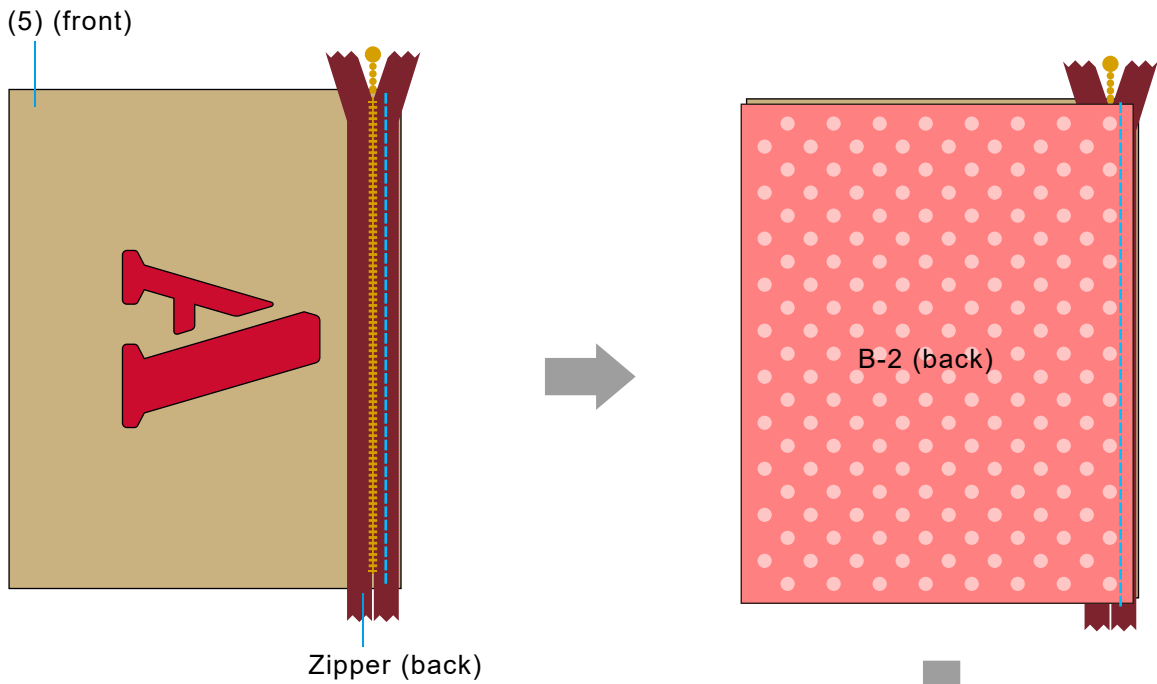
(5) Stack C on the back of A, and then attach them with craft adhesive, as shown below.



Lightly apply adhesive.

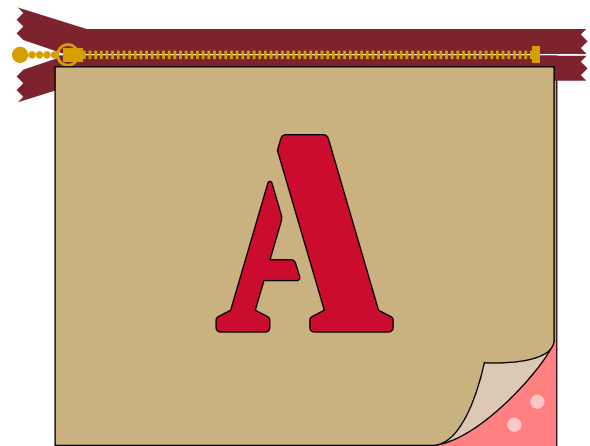


(6) With their right sides together, sew together the piece assembled in step (5) and the zipper, as shown below. Stack B-2 on top and sew together, and then turn the piece assembled in step (5) and B-2 right sides out.

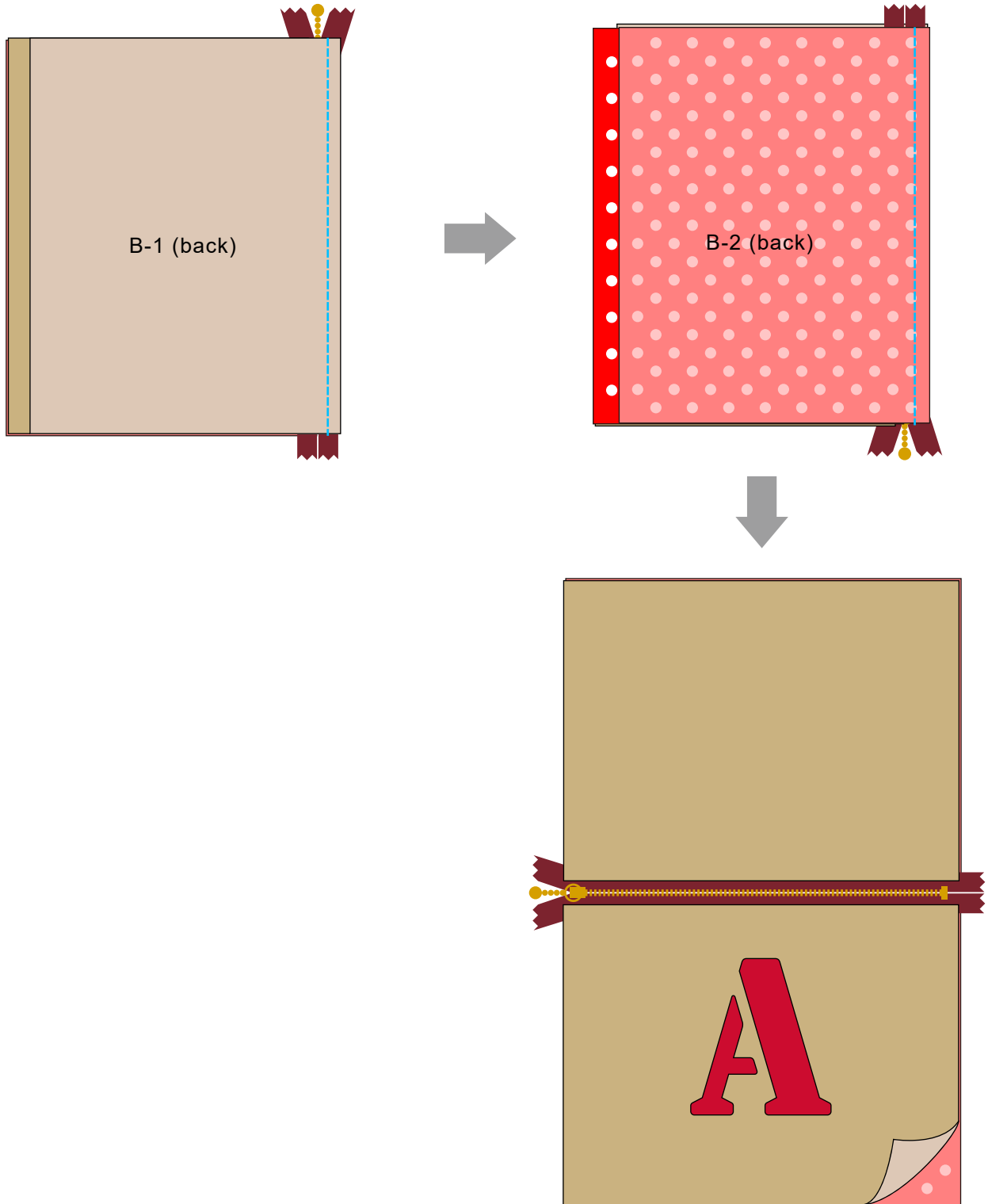


When sewing the zipper, use the zipper foot. Move the zipper slider while sewing so it does not contact the presser foot.

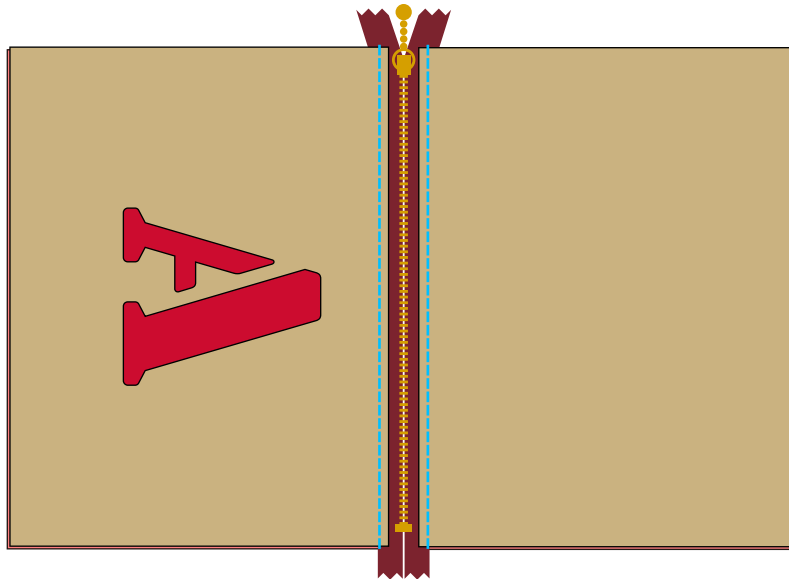
When ironing the cork sheet, use a low temperature and frequently check the condition of the material.



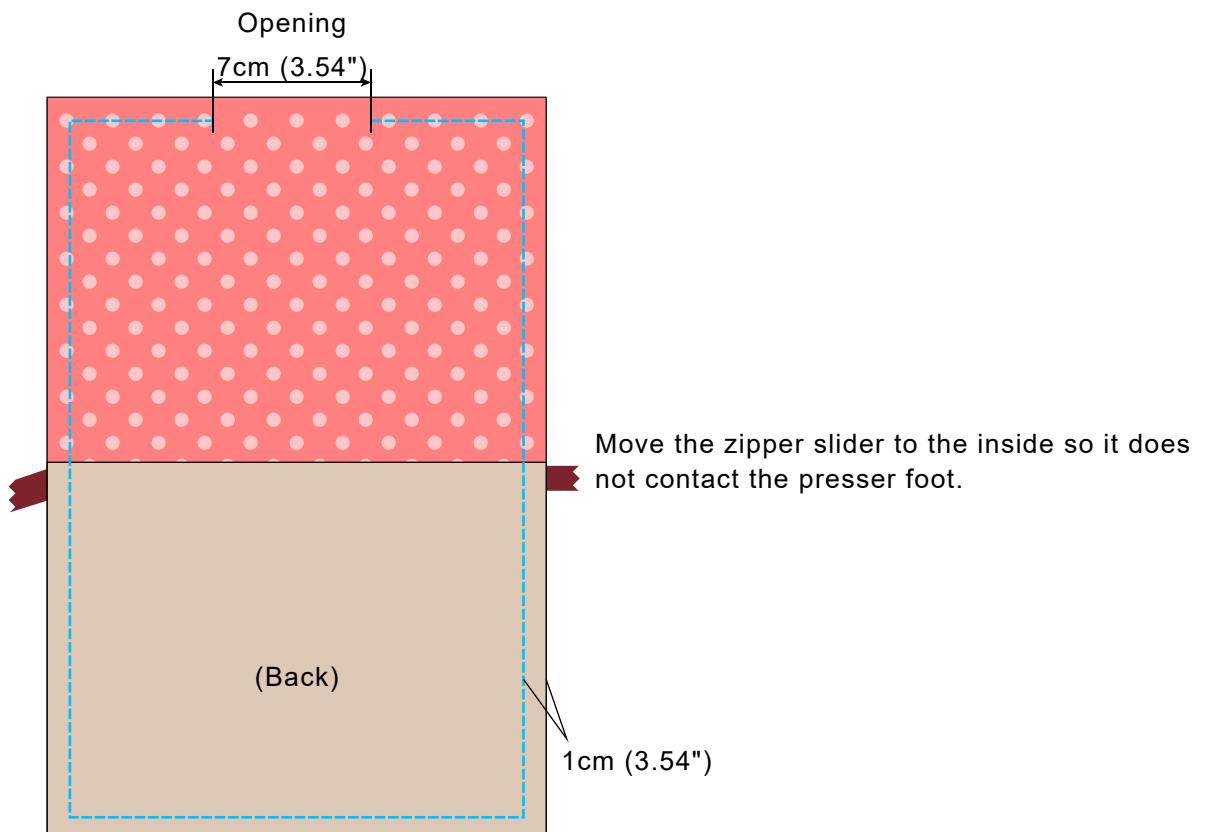
(7) In the same way, sew B-1 to the other side of the zipper with their right sides together. Turn over, stack B-2 on top, and then sew together. Turn B-1 and B-2 right sides out.



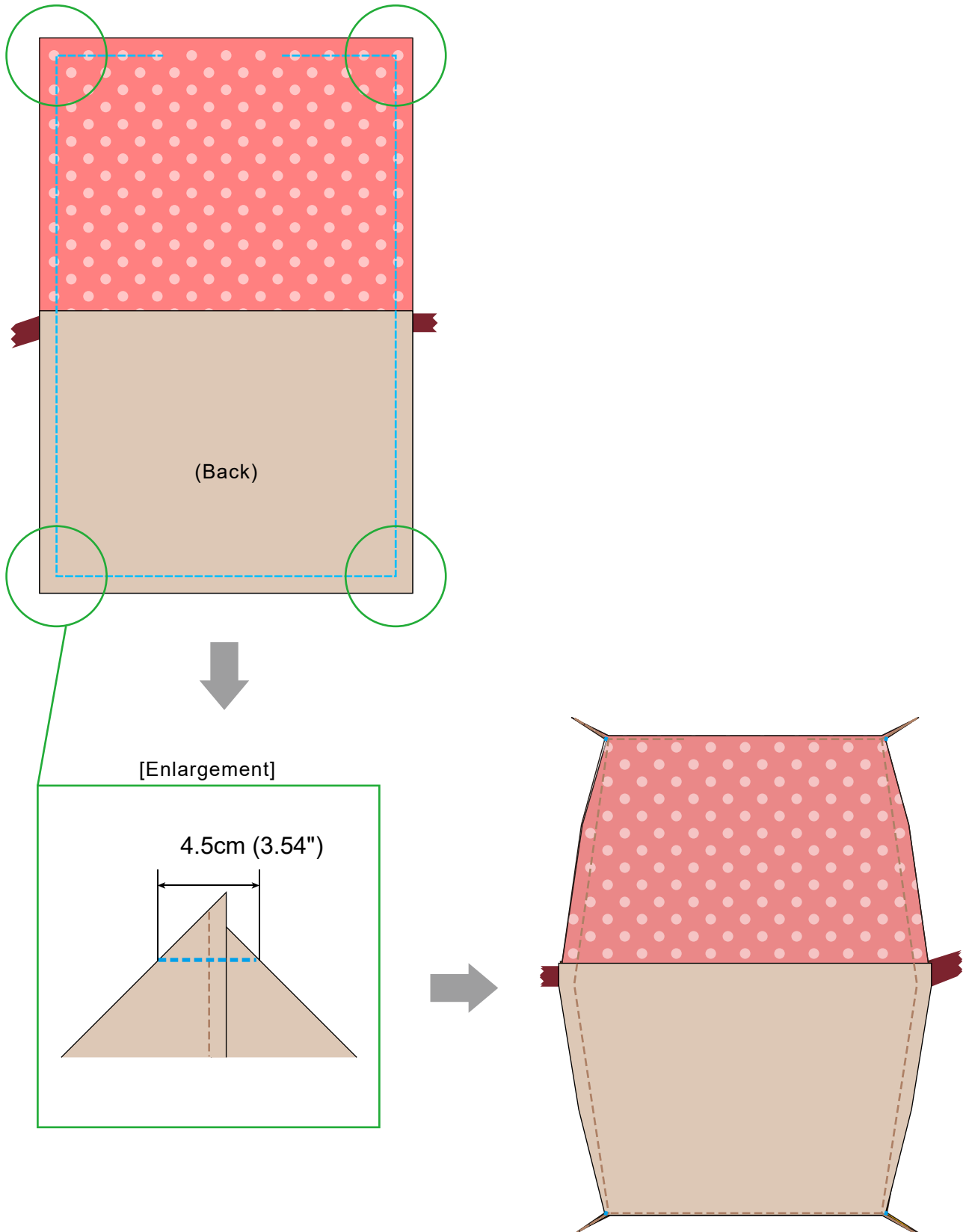
(8) Topstitch along both sides of the zipper.



(9) Separately stack the cork pieces and the fabric pieces with their right sides together, as shown below. Sew 1 cm (0.39") in from the edge of the fabric, leaving an opening.



(10) Fold each of the four corners into a triangle as shown below, and then mark the location where the width is 4.5 cm.



(11) Turn right side out through the opening, and then sew the opening closed. Insert the lining into the bag, and then reshape.
