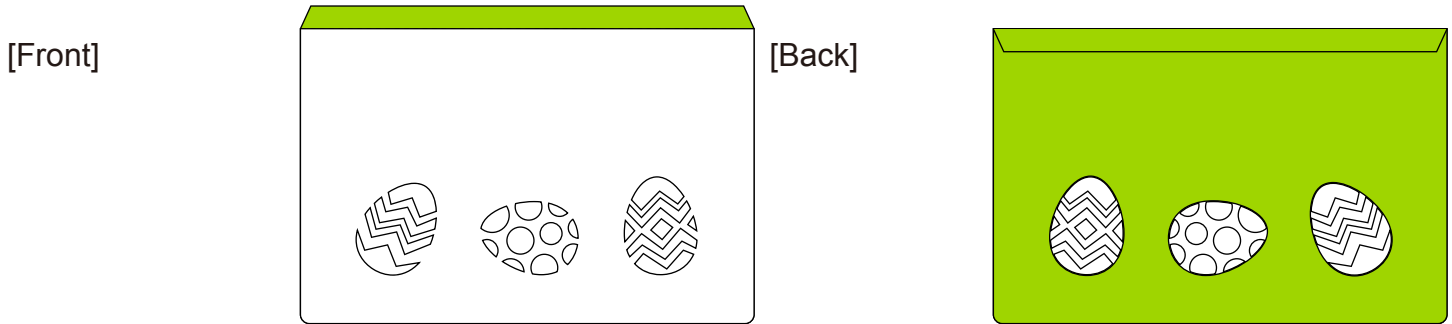
Material

- Paper – 3 kinds
- Hard felt – 3 kinds
- Ribbon
- Glue
- Double-sided tape
- Foam adhesive square
- Iron-on adhesive sheet

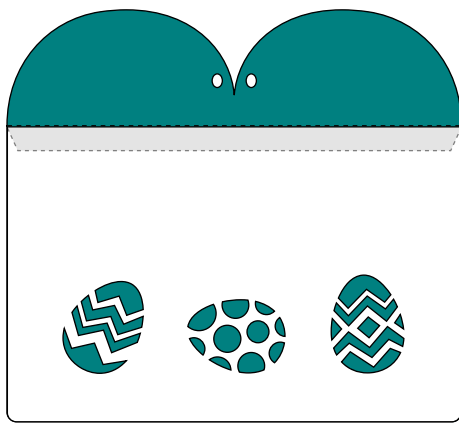
(1) Cut out the parts. For D-1 through D-3, attach iron-on adhesive sheet to the back of the hard felt before cutting. (For details on attaching the sheet, refer to the instructions included with it.)



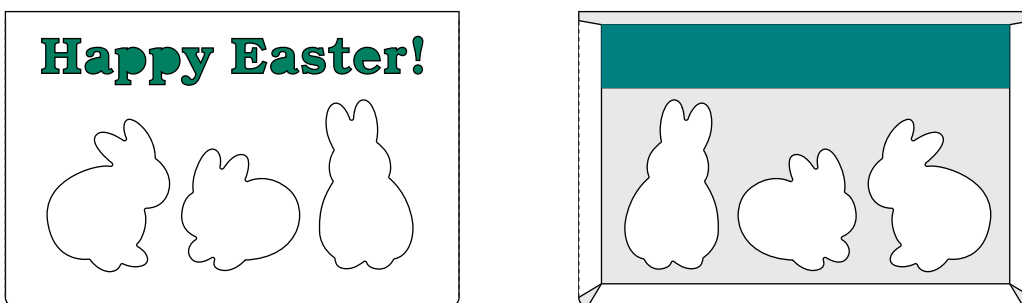
(2) Align the egg shapes and glue together A-1 and B, and then fold over the tab.



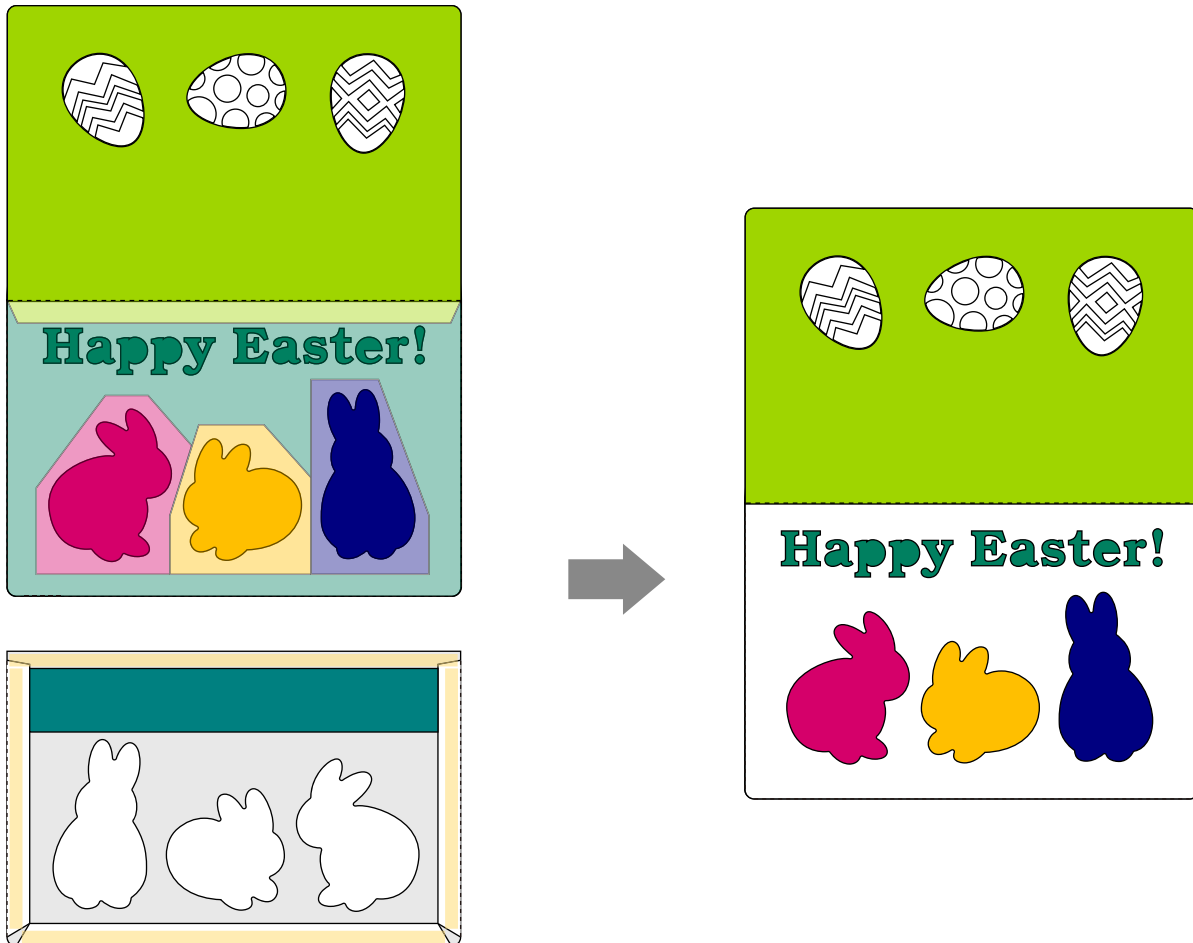
(3) Align the piece with the dotted line on C-1, and then glue on the tab, as shown below. Do not glue any area other than the tab.



(4) Glue C-2 over the text in A-2 from the back, and then fold over the tabs along the dotted lines.



(5) Open the piece assembled in step (3), place the piece assembled in step (4) on top of it, and then align parts D-1 through D-3 with the rabbit cutouts and glue them on, as shown below. Stack the piece assembled in step (4) on top and glue it on.



(6) Pass the ribbon through the holes and tie it, and then attach the foam adhesive squares to the back of the cover and secure them.
